

Privacy statement PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V.

Introduction:

This statement applies to all products and services provided by PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. with its registered office in Yerseke is responsible for the processing of personal data as mentioned in this privacy statement.

Personal data we process

PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you have provided it to us. Data which PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. may need from you or is necessary with regard to the objectives as listed below and that PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. in any case and at least processes include:

- Initials and surname
- Gender
- Date of birth
- Company name
- Address details (consisting of street name, house number and ZIP code)
- Telephone number (mobile or fixed line)
- E-mail address
- Bank details

Does PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. also process special personal data?

Special personal data concerns sensitive data, for example about your health or a criminal record, ethnical data or data concerning race. PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. does not process special personal data.

Why we need data

As soon as you have entered into an agreement with PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V., we want to be of service to you in the best possible way. We will therefore use your data for the following objectives:

- To call or e-mail you if the performance of our services requires it.
- To inform you about changes in our services and products.
- In order to deliver products and services to you.
- If we are legally obliged thereto, like data we need for our tax declaration.
- Data can also be used for promotional or marketing purposes that relate to the type of services provision by PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. For example, in order to inform you through our newsletter about a new activity of PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. If you do not want to receive our newsletter, you can click on the button 'deregister' at the end of the newsletter.

We can solely use your data for any other objective than originally intended, if both objectives are closely related.

Which rules apply to the processing of personal data?

In the processing of personal data, PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. is bound by applicable laws and legislation and keeps up to date with relevant developments. In this meaning PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. retains the right to change the privacy statement in order to link the text to the latest state of affairs, as mentioned at the end of the privacy statement.

How long do we save data?

PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. will save your data no longer than strictly necessary and in order to put into practice the objectives for which your data was collected.

Sharing with others/provision of data to third parties

PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. does not sell your data to third parties and only provides it when absolutely necessary to perform our agreement with you or if it complies with a legal obligation. We enter into agreements with processing agents to ensure a similar level of security and confidentiality of your data.

Record of website visits (public section)

PRO-SEA Underwater Inspections B.V. only uses technical and functional cookies. A cookie is a tiny text file that is saved on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you visit our websites for the first time. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical processing of the websites and for your ease of use. They ensure that the websites function properly and remember your configuration preferences. You are able to deregister cookies by configuring your internet browser in such a way that cookies are no longer saved. In addition, you can delete all information that was earlier saved by changing your browser settings.

Embedded content from other websites
